This 4-day continuing professional development course is designed for Clinicians already working psychotherapeutically in the field of dissociation, ritual abuse and mind control. The course will be working from an Attachment-based perspective and will be exploring the neuroscience of trauma and dissociation and will be using some case vignettes to look at how trauma can manifest in people with disabilities and how music therapy can support people with learning disabilities. We will be reflecting on relational skills using key concepts for working with this complex group of people.

The collaborators offering this course share a relational psychoanalytic perspective. They also recognise that psychotherapists working with extreme trauma may have to adapt their approach and the course will be as inclusive as possible.
